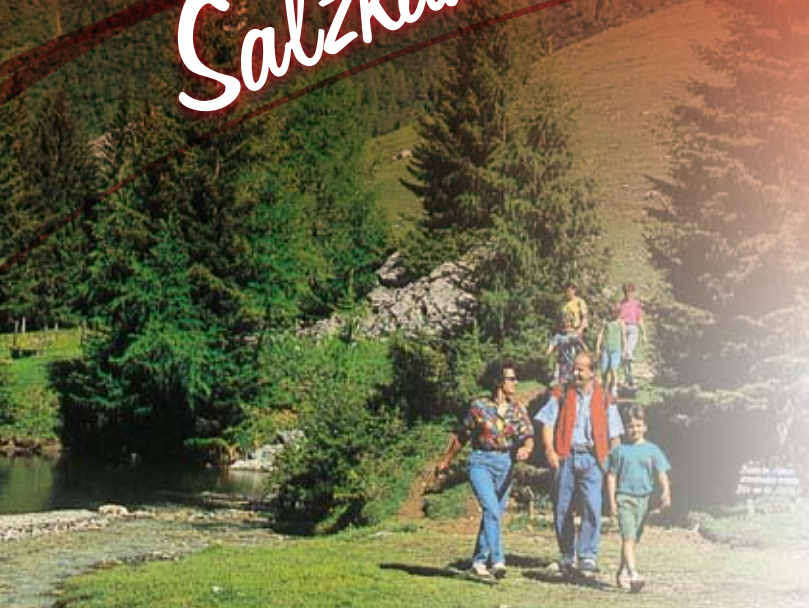


Salzkammergut Lakes Walking Tour



Discover the many hidden secrets and mysteries of this enchanting region. Walking tours allow you to explore the history and culture on foot, experiencing the region for its true charm. There are 76 lakes and some of them are known even for towns like St. Wolfgang, Mondsee and Gmunden on their shores, while others are solitary and hidden. Your route will take you over mountains and across lakes, past natural spectacles and famous places.

Day 1 Arrival in St Wolfgang

Individual arrival, check-in and hand out of the travel documents.

Day 2 St. Wolfgang – boat trip to Abersee – Strobl – St. Wolfgang

(approx. 11 kms/ 4 hours) By ferry, cross lake "Wolfgangsee" and reach the peninsula Abersee. Walk along the shore through the nature reserve "Blinkingmoos". Cross the lake promenade in Strobl to reach the lookout "Bürglsteig". Along the lake shore, walk back to St. Wolfgang.

Day 3 St. Wolfgang – Unterach (approx. 18 kms/ 5 hours)

Today's stage leads you from "St. Wolfgang" on the path "Sattelweg" to lake short Schwarzensee for a rest at a comfortable inn. After a little break, walk over the alpine pasture region of Eisenau into the gorge where you will be fascinated by the natural spectacle "Burggraben Klamm". Then follow the east shore of the lake "Attersee" to "Unterach".

Day 4 Unterach – Egelsee – Nussdorf – ship to Unterach (approx. 13 kms/ 5 hours)

Hike through the forest Buchwald to the nature reserve Egelsee to admire rare plants and twelve different types of orchids. Walk along the west shore to Nussdorf and take the boat back to Unterach.

Day 5 Unterach – Fuschl am See (approx. 11 kms/ 4 hours)

Go by bus from Unterach to Mondsee and visit the colourful market place with the wonderful collegiate church which was used as a setting in the "Sound of Music". Walk along the lake and over meadows in direction of the "Drachenwand" to find the remains of the castle "Wartenfels". Once there, take a break at an inn before walking to Fuschl am See.

Day 6 Around lake "Fuschlsee" (approx. 12 kms/ 3,5 hours)

Hike around lake "Fuschlsee" on a quite easy path through woods and over meadows. On the terrace of the castle, enjoy a cup of coffee.

Day 7 Fuschl – St. Gilgen – mountain railway Schafberg (approx. 15 kms/ 4,5 hours)

The way leads along the stream into the valley "Ellmau" and to the inn "Hochlackenhof". Take a rest and admire the wonderful lake "Wolfgangsee". Via St. Gilgen, along the lake shore to Fürberg and take the ship to St. Wolfgang. The historical rack railway leads to the top of the mountain Schafberg. Stay overnight on this mountain at a height of 1.780 metres and enjoy a splendid view over the wonderful Salzkammergut region.

Day 8 Downhill with the "Schafbergbahn", departure or additional nights.
